

Training on Unified Accounts Code Structure (UACS) and Online Submission of Budget Proposals System (OSBPS)

5 March, 2013



In preparation for the adoption of government-wide harmonized budgetary and accounting classification and automation of budget proposals submission, the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) is set to train the national government agencies on the Unified Accounts Code Structure (UACS) and Online Submission of Budget Proposals System (OSBPS) starting 5-22 March 2013.

The UACS will provide common classification of accounts and codes and will enable comparison of allotment releases with appropriations, obligations with releases, and actual disbursements with obligations for programs /projects/activities. The OSBPS, on one hand, will enable the central office of all departments/agencies to encode their consolidated budget proposal into the web-based system starting with FY 2014 budget preparation.

The training shall assist the financial management staff of departments/agencies understand and apply the new UACS in the preparation of budget proposals for FY 2014 and in financial reporting, and how to use OSBPS. The training will be conducted in two phases for different set of audience viz. Budget Officers/Staff for Phase 1 and Financial Managers and Technical Staff including Accountants, Planning Officers and Auditors for Phase 2.

The Phase 1 of the training will be held in two (2) days per class from 8:30-5:30 pm at The Linden Suites, Ortigas Center, Pasig City.

The training dates for Phase 1 are as follows:

2nd Batch: March 7-8

3rd Batch: March 12-13

4th Batch: March 14-15

5th Batch: March 19-20

6th Batch: March 21-22
