Public Financial Management (PFM) Committee

Resolution No. 01-2012

Whereas, Under GIFMIS Committee Resolution No. 02-2011, dated July 12, 2011, the Project Management Office (PMO) and other organizational units have been created to plan, implement, monitor and evaluate the successful accomplishment of the objectives of the projects to implement the Public Financial Management (PFM) Reforms Roadmap;

Whereas, PFM Committee Resolution No. 03-2011, dated October 14, 2011, approved to change the name of the PMO from Project Management Office to Program Management Office to align its name to its function of assisting the PFM Committee in the overall management of the PFM Reforms Program, and likewise adopted the Terms of Reference (TOR) for the PMO and Project Implementation Units (PIUs);

Whereas, In the same PFM Committee Resolution No. 03-2011, DBM Undersecretary Richard E. Moya and COA Assistant Commissioner Arcadio B. Cuenco, Jr., have been designated to act as the PMO Director and Deputy Director, respectively, and the present PFM Committee Secretariat as PMO Administrative and Finance Staff, in the interim;

Whereas, Given the important role the PMO plays in the implementation of the PFM Reforms Roadmap, there is a need to appoint regular PMO Director and PMO Deputy Director as soon as possible;

Whereas, The PIUs for GIFMIS Development Project and Capacity Building have signified the urgent need of international experts on GIFMIS and capacity building;

Whereas, Applications for the initial four PMO positions have been received by the Philippines-Australia Public Financial Management Program (PFMP), and closed on January 6, 2012, as follows:

- a. PMO Director (International) – 22 applicants
- b. PMO Deputy Director (National) – 19 applicants
- c. GIFMIS Expert (International) – 19 applicants
- d. Capacity Building Expert (National) – 28 applicants


Whereas, The applicants have to be ranked and selected based on the criteria provided for by the PFMP;
